1 General Provisions

This order is issued to protect against the introduction and spread of COVID-19.

With regard to the situation concerning the development of the infection with COVID-19 disease, the Rector of the Technical University of Liberec sets out the following measures concerning the employees and students of the Technical University of Liberec (hereinafter referred to as "TUL").

2 Personal Presence of Students in Class

Personal presence of university students in lessons and examinations if more than 10 persons take part in the examination at the same time, and participants in a lifelong learning courses is, based on Resolution of the Government of the Czech Republic No. 13 with effect from January 1, 2021 from 00:00 to January 22, 2021 to 23:59, prohibited.

The ban on personal presence of students does not apply to:

- participation in clinical and practical teaching and practice of students in study programmes in general medicine, dentistry, pharmacy and other health study programmes and programmes and students performing pedagogical practical teaching and practice in kindergartens, primary and secondary schools or school facilities for the performance of institutional and protective education.
- Participation in university entrance examinations with the participation of a maximum of 10 people,
- Participation in individual consultations (only one student and one member of academic staff).

The student participates in practical teaching, examinations and consultations only if the following conditions are met:

- S/he does not have any acute health problems corresponding to a viral infectious disease (e. g. fever, cough, shortness of breath, sudden loss of taste and smell, etc.).



- S/he shall disinfect their hands at the entrance of the building and at the entrance to the examination room.
- S/he has not been ordered to take quarantine measures at that time.

All teaching is the responsibility of and shall be permitted by individual faculties. Course guarantors, in agreement with individual teachers, are obliged to contact the students by e-mail without undue delay and inform them about the next steps of teaching. They are obliged to ensure contactless teaching with the help of standard tools supported by secure and legal TUL information systems. Course guarantors are obliged to report the method of teaching to the deans of individual faculties.

3 Accommodation of Students in Dormitories

Pursuant to the Resolution of the Government of the Czech Republic No. 13 with effect from January 11, 2021 from 00:00 to January 22, 2021 to 23:59 it is forbidden to accommodate university students who have another residence in the Czech Republic, in university accommodation facilities.

The ban on accommodation in university accommodation facilities does not apply to:

Students to whom the ban on personal presence under point 2 of this order does not apply.

Based on additional information from the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports to limit the operation of university accommodation facilities pursuant to the Resolution of the Government of the Czech Republic, students who can also stay in the university accommodation facility are those:

- for whom the accommodation facility of the university is a residence according to the provisions of Section 80 (1) of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code, as amended, and that fact has to be proved to the university by an official statement. These students can stay accommodated in the university accommodation facility. Residence is the place where a person stays with the intention of living there permanently, subject to a change of circumstances,
- who are accommodated in a university accommodation and at the same time have an employment relationship with a university (for example, some PhD students), these students may remain in the university accommodation for the purpose of work.

If a student is being tested for COVID-19 and/or waits for the results of these tests, s/he remains accommodated in the accommodation facility of the university until the result of the test is obtained. In the case of a positive test result, the student remains in quarantine/isolation in the university accommodation facility.

4 Obligation to Wear Respiratory Protective Equipment

The obligation to wear respiratory protective equipment is determined by the current measures of the Ministry of Health. All TUL employees and students are obliged to comply with the valid measures of the Ministry of Health or other public administration bodies, which are available on the website: <https://koronavirus.mzcr.cz/en/>

All students and employees of TUL are obliged to enter the interior of the university with respiratory protective equipment.

5 Notification obligation

Due to the protection of public health and the health of employees and students, all TUL employees and students are obliged to immediately report a positive test for COVID-19 or quarantine via the form at: <https://liane.tul.cz/covid>.

6 Organizing Events

The Rector calls to limit the organization of unnecessary events. The Rector shall decide on the necessity of the event at the rectorate, the Dean at the Faculty, the Director at the University Institute, and the Director at the university-wide facility. When organizing the event, it is necessary to follow the current measures of the Ministry of Health.

7 Final Provisions

TUL is governed by the legal regulations and measures of the Ministry of Health or other public administration bodies adopted in connection with protection against COVID-19 disease, as amended, and does not introduce measures that would determine the rights or obligations beyond legal norms and measures.

This order No. 12/2020 shall be valid until revoked.
